

Which Certifications Does IQCB Offer?

IQCB has two certification programs:

There are different levels of certification based on the professional health care background of the clinician and how the different modalities will be used professionally.

- **Diplomate Certification** is available for individuals with local/state licensure in an approved health care field or by presenting evidence of competency via CV or publications for board approval. [link]
- **Technologist Certification** is available for individuals who work under a QEEG Diplomate mentor's license.
- **Certification by Prior Experience (CPE)** is available for both the Diplomate and the Technologist level certifications. See below.

All certification programs include a requirement of strict adherence to the IQCB [Professional Standards and Ethical Principles](#)

Certification program is based on:

- prerequisite educational degrees (except for the Technologist certification)
- didactic course work that is based on the [Blueprint of Knowledge](#) statements that cover the fundamental science, history, and theory of brain analysis specific to that certification program
- clinical training and [mentoring](#) to learn the application of skills under the supervision of a IQCB Diplomate.
- successful certification [exam](#) completion

Certification based on Prior Experience (CPE) Criteria

- current license/credential in a IQCB approved health care field issued by the state in which you practice
- an advanced amount of accredited post-professional education that covered the original didactic training based on the appropriate blueprint as well as many other hours in blueprint-relevant topic
- contact hours of mentoring with another professional when you first added this modality to your practice
- an advanced number of patient hours over at least 5 years using the modality in a clinical setting
- Statement of clinical practice that describes your clinical work
- 3 letters of recommendation that have reviewed your statement and agree with that summary of your work
- completion of the written certification exam with no expected pass score for validation purposes

Certification is no substitute for a state-sanctioned license. IQCB's certificants must carry an appropriate license/credential valid in the state of practice in an IQCB-approved health care field when treating a medical or psychological disorder. If unlicensed, the certificant must work under appropriate supervision. The licensing body of the clinician's provider, or their supervisor, has legal jurisdiction over their clinical practice.

Recertification: Certifications are valid for 4 years for Diplomates and Technologists. Recertification is granted upon application, payment of fees, and documentation of accredited continuing education specific to the Blueprint of Knowledge, and adherence to the IQCB [Professional Standards and Ethical Principles](#).
