The International QEEG Certification Board (IQCB) honors the life and contributions of Jonathan Edward Walker, IQCB Past President

We have lost a dear friend and colleague, Jonathan Edward Walker, M.D., M.S., EEG, B.C.N., QEEG-Diplomate Emeritus.

Dr. Walker (Jon) graduated from Baylor College of Medicine in 1965, was a Board-Certified Neurologist for sixty years and Past President of the International QEEG Certification Board.

He studied, researched, and taught in the field of neuroscience. He combined traditional neurological medical practice with QEEG-guided neurotherapy (EEG-neurofeedback). He found that neurotherapy is more effective when it is guided by the QEEG (brain map) and when the sessions are monitored by trained therapists who offer guidance for this effective, advanced treatment.

He was the recipient of The Career Achievement Award from the International Society for Neurofeedback and Research and The Presidential Recognition Award from AAPB. He is nationally recognized in the field of neurotherapy and QEEG.

We feel honored to have known and worked with him for many years and are grateful for his contributions to the field. We extend our deepest condolences to his family, friends and colleagues.
